We are delighted to announce the Laboratory's participation in the graduate seminar: *Archaeology of the Roman Empire for the Study of New Testament and Early Christianity* of Yale Divinity School and Yale University Department of Religious Studies. This seminar "introduces students to working with archaeological data from the Greco-Roman world, inscriptions, architecture, sculpture, coins, and its connection with the New Testament and Early Christian World. The seminar's sessions taking place in Greece and Turkey during May, including meetings with archaeologists and other scholars."

Led by Dr. Laura Nasrallah, Buckingham Professor of New Testament Criticism and Interpretation at Yale Divinity School and Yale University Department of Religious Studies, this in situ seminar explores various aspects of the field.
